**CITY OF CHATSWORTH
COUNCIL MEETING
MAY 3, 2010**

The Chatsworth City council met in regular session on Monday, May 3, 2010, at 6:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers of City Hall with Mayor Tyson Haynes presiding.

PRESENT: Mayor Tyson Haynes, Aldermen Wayne Graves, Celeste Martin, Gary Brock and Fred Welch. City Attorney Steve Williams and City Clerk Wilma Nolan.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA: Mayor Haynes called for a review of the tentative agenda for any additions or deletions. Mayor Haynes called for a motion, hearing no comments.

Wayne, "I make a motion we accept the agenda." Gary seconded and the motion passed by a vote of 4 to 0.

MINUTES: Mayor Haynes called for review of the April 5, 2010 minutes as presented. Mayor Haynes entertained a motion for adoption of the minutes as presented.

NEW BUSINESS

SHIRLEY THURSTON WISHES TO ADDRESS THE COUNCIL - Ms. Thurston's question was in regard to hiring an Economic Development Manager.

Mayor Haynes advised this was in the discussion stage with the county and it would be presented to the council to act on in the form of an intergovernmental agreement. This could be presented at the June meeting.

PATTY SCHOEN-JONES AND MICHAEL R. JONES WISH TO ADDRESS THE COUNCIL - Ms. Jones inquired if the bridge that was going in was being funded by the city or the county.

Mayor Haynes advised that the project itself was a state project. Ms. Jones wanted to know the purpose of the project.

Mayor Haynes advised that providing safety at all at grade railroad crossings was a primary goal of the Highway Administration and the DOT.

I. General

INFRASTRUCTURE: Gary advised that the water works had completed the Cisco project. The Water Works Commission audit has been completed.

The street department has been busy this month with keepign drainage open. The striping was completed on 4-22-10. They had picked up 38 loads trash, 67 loads brush, 12 loads of commercial garbage and 18 loads of residential garbage.

INTERGOVERNMENTAL & TECHNOLOGY - Presentation of an ordinance to amend the code of ordinances captioned "Soil Erosion, Sedimentation Control" for the first reading.

Gary, "I make a motion we accept this as the first reading." Wayne seconded and the motion passed by a vote of 4 to 0.

Ms. Martin advised that she had hoped the web site was going to be up by May but due to third party collaboration we are still waiting and are shooting for June.

PUBLIC SAFETY: Fred presented the reports for review. Chief Martin was not in attendance and Sgt. Bickford was available for any questions. It was noted that there were less burglaries and break -ins.

Chief Baxter advised he had attended a pandemic training this month. He had two individuals to receive their state firefighters certification, Simon Bishop and Jordon Parker.

The Georgia Legislature closed on April 30, 2010. The budget was set at 10% less than last year's budget.

HB277 passed the legislature and NG991 - LOST Arbitration also passed.

HB 480 did not pass nor did SB345.
