The resolution reads as follows:

R E S O L U T I O N

"TO RECOGNIZE AND MEMORIALIZE THE PUBLIC SERVICE OF MR. JERRY SANFORD, MS. MARGARET ADAMS, AND MR. KENNETH WILBURN"

WHEREAS, The Chatsworth city council wishes to ensure that the log time contributions and service to the City of Chatsworth will not be forgotten, and

WHEREAS, Mr. Sanford served as Mayor for twenty (20) years, and during that time the City of Chatsworth prospered and Mr. Sanford devoted his time and effort to serve the citizens, and of the many projects Mr. Sanford drove, the completion of the City Park was a main theme, and

WHEREAS, Ms. Margaret Adams served the City of Chatsworth for thirty-seven (37) years as a council member. Ms. Adams was devoted to improving all areas of the City in recreation and maintaining historical sites. Ms. Adams was the longest serving member of the City of Chatsworth, and

WHEREAS, Mr. Kenneth Wilburn served the City of Chatsworth for thirty (30) years, and during this service he devoted his time, effort and experience in updating and upgrading the Public Safety of the City of Chatsworth, so

THEREFORE, the Chatsworth City Council proclaims and directs that the following dedications and monuments be erected and appropriate ceremonies be held for their service and accomplishments.

1. The Chatsworth City Council by this resolution proclaims, and directs that an appropriate monument be erected in the Chatsworth City Park, and the City Park be dedicated to former Mayor Sanford for his efforts and vision in developing the City Park.

3. COMMITTEE REPORTS

FINANCE: Wayne Graves stated all departments were within their budget and capital reserves are taking care of the capital purchases.

Request approval for the City Clerk to attend Municipal Court Clerk Certification classes, November 2-3, 2010, Georgia Center, Athens.

INFRASTRUCTURE: Gary stated the water commission meets the third Tuesday of each month for those wishing to attend.

The street department disposed of 29 loads of trash, 48 loads brush, 16 loads residential garbage and 9 commercial loads of garbage.

Sit streets were paved including Market Street and a drop box was completed on Fort Mountain Drive. The Christmas lights are being hung and the fountain drained for the winter months.

Mayor Haynes advised that the city would be receiving a contract for LARP resurfacing for Lowy Drive for \$30,000.

INTERGOVERNMENTAL & TECHNOLOGY: Council woman Martin advised that the Alcohol Ordinance had been completed and the website was in operation and seeing activity.

PUBLIC SAFETY: Chief Martin advised they had 876 dispatches for the month with no burglaries. Also, there were 34 accidents.

Chief Baxter advised they had just completed Fire Safety Education touching 1100 school children. The Flames training course was held on October 15, 16, 17 with 12 graduates out of a class of 20.

Officer Smith advised he had been dealing with several sign issues- some portable, which had been removed.
