COUNCIL MEETING  
JULY 2, 2012**

The Chatsworth City Council met in regular session on Monday, July 2, 2012 at 6:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers of City Hall with Mayor Dan Penland presiding.

**PRESENT:** Mayor Dan Penland, Aldermen: Wayne Graves, Gary Brock and Fred Welch. Celeste Martin was present via phone conference. City Clerk Wilma Nolan.

Mayor Penland called the meeting to order and advised that the minutes of the last meeting and agenda are in your packet for review and I will entertain a motion to approve the agenda and minutes.

**COMMITTEE REPORTS**

**FINANCE:** I have reviewed the budget for June and each one of the departments is within the budget and our revenues are running about what we budgeted.

**INFRASTRUCTURE:** Gary advised that a report was available for the street department and they have been staying busy with brush, mowing and all kinds of projects.

Gary inquired of Steve Smith if he had any other things to bring up. Steve brought up the lot behind the park where the old water plan used to be and advised that they wanted to turn that lot over to the City. Gary advised that the Chamber was wanting this and wanting it paved. I don't see us paving that lot.

Celeste inquired who was doing the work on Fourth, Fifth and Sixth Avenues. Gary inquired if the gas company was back in here. Everett advised that they were on Long Avenue. The gas company will be coming back to repair from their line upgrade projects.

**INTERGOVERNMENTAL AND TECHNOLOGY:** Celeste advised the proposal for the LOST to county had been presented. Eton has presented them a proposal. They have not looked at them or studied them. They will be getting back with us.

Celeste inquired of the status of the trailer. Dolley advised the trailer is being replaced as allowed in the ordinance.

**PUBLIC SAFETY:** Fred advised that Chief Martin has his reports and the probation reports for May and June. Chief Martin advised that Wagon Train was quiet. There were 762 dispatches for the month and accidents are staying down.

Fred inquired about having a speed limit sign posted going west on the four lane. Terry advised that he and Everett were working on this request.

Chief Baxter advised that it had been a quiet month. He advised that flow tests and maintenance on the hydrants was almost complete. Jason Castoe went over to the police and fire games in Dalton and served as judge for the toughest firefighter competition. Two of our part-time guys competed and one of them won the overall title. He works full-time at the Dalton Fire Department, Robbie Townsend.

Wayne inquired if his disposal included the final commercial pickup. Gary advised that the commercial service pickups were completed on June 29, 2012.

There being no further business to come before the council, Mayor Penland called for a motion to adjourn.
