**CITY OF CHATSWORTH
COUNCIL MEETING
FEBRUARY 1, 2016**

The Chatsworth City Council met in regular session on Monday, February 1, 2016, at 6:00 p.m. in the council chambers of City Hall with Mayor Tyson Haynes presiding.

PRESENT: Mayor Tyson Haynes, Aldermen: Brad Rowe, Celeste Martin, Jeff Cloer and Fred Welch. City Attorney Steve Williams and City Clerk Wilma Nolan.

Mayor Haynes presented the minutes of last meeting and the agenda for this meeting. Please review these.

Celeste, "I make the motion to accept these." Brad seconded and the motion passed by a vote of 4 to 0.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

FINANCE. Brad Rowe stated there were not any major expenditures or purchases that were unexpected. We are at 96% collection of the 2015 tax collections.

ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT, TOURISM AND DOWNTOWN DEVELOPMENT: Celeste reported there was a relocation of a business to 411 North (Stover's Upholstery and Muffler).

We are going to update and republish our codification of ordinances but we have an amendment to the zoning ordinance which is in process that we would like to complete so it can be as up to date as possible. We anticipate having the first reading of this amendment in March.

The website has been updated. In a thirty day period we had 10,433 hits to the site. The predominate amount of those were the home page and redirecting to the jobs page, community calendar and police.

There will be an audio-visual professional to come out on Tuesday to see what it will take to add audio-visual equipment and recording to this room.

PUBLIC SAFETY: Fred advised that the police and fire have their reports in your packet.

Chief Baxter advised that it was an average month. Mayor Haynes inquired if the staffing issue was resolved. Chief Baxter advised that the hiring date would be 07-01-16 and we would be within budget to make those hires at that time.

Chief Etheridge reported they had experienced the second suicide with a firearm in six months. We have had two instructors complete the civilian active shooter course at the training trainer course. We have one of our own training courses coming up February 12.

Chief Baxter advised he and other members of the department went to Alpharetta Department of Public Safety for a TEARS course. This is to teach firefighters and first responder how to respond to an active shooter event with law enforcement to provide initial care to the wounded in a hostile environment.

Since then we have gotten together with Josh and his department to train our two departments together in how to mesh those so we will know how to respond should this happen in our community. We have purchased four gear bags, 3 for the fire department and one for the patrol car. We completed a drill with all public safety agencies at the Gladden Middle School to simulate two shooters in the building.

PUBLIC WORKS: Jeff advised he had been working on repairs for the roof at the fire department, the training room at the police department and removing a wall at city hall.

Everett advised they had removed 16 loads of waste and 35 loads of brush, 18 loads of garbage. The also removed several trees due to high winds.

EXECUTIVE SESSION: There are no items for executive session.

Mayor Haynes adjourned the meeting at 6:25 p.m.
