The Chatsworth City Council met in regular session on Monday, April 6, 2015 at 6:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers of City Hall with Mayor Dan Penland presiding.

PRESENT: Mayor Dan Penland, Aldermen: Brad Rowe, Celeste Martin, Gary Brock and Fred Welch. City Attorney Steve Williams and City Clerk Wilma Nolan.

Mayor Penland presented the minutes of the last meeting and the agenda for today's meeting for review and approval.

Celeste, "I make a motion we accept these as presented." Gary seconded and the motion passed by a vote of 4 to 0.

Presentation of an amendment to the City of Chatsworth Ordinance for Post Development Stormwater Management for new development and redevelopment for a second reading -

The reason for the amendment is to make it match the county. So that when a developer comes in here the regulations will be the same for the city and the county.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

FINANCE: Alderman Rowe stated he had reviewed the revenue stream along with the expenses of each of the departments, we seem to be pretty much on track for the year.

INFRASTRUCTURE: Gary advised that there was a lot of cleanup and debris for the month. The work on Duvall Road will begin soon. The heavy concrete pipe is on site. Mohawk will do all the construction if we buy the materials. The city and the county are splitting the cost of the pipe and fittings for the project.

INTERGOVERNMENTAL & TECHNOLOGY: Dolley advised they had received a lot of complaints dealing with cleanup and rubbish. She further advised that the soil and erosion ordinance will be amended in the months to come.

PUBLIC SAFETY: Alderman Welch presented the reports for the month of March for the Fire and Police departments.

Chief Baxter advised that the siren testing for the month of April was skipped due to it being April Fool's Day. Last month Brigham Young graduated from the Smoke Diver Program, he attended last fall and did not make it. However, he was successful this time.

Chief Baxter advised they had held their Flames course the last weekend in March and graduated 15 of 25 students.

The Fire Department will be providing assistance to the Dalton Fire Department to cover their stations during the funeral of recently retired Fire Chief Gary Baggett who had passed away over the weekend.

Chief Etheridge advised that domestic calls had doubled since last month. There were 34 drug arrests for the month of March. We responded to 1847 calls for the month.

EXECUTIVE SESSION: None

Frank Adams advised that the Historical Society is planning to open the hotel and depot the second Saturday of each month from May to September. A live band will be playing at the Depot. We have bands and sponsors for each month. The first one is set for May 9th.

The Amnesty Day for the landfill is April 25, 2015.

There being no further business, Mayor Penland adjourned the meeting at 6:20 p.m.
