The Chatsworth City Council met in regular session on Monday, May 4, 2015 at 6:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers of City Hall with Mayor Dan Penland presiding.

PRESENT: Mayor Dan Penland, Aldermen: Brad Rowe, Celeste Martin and Gary Brock. City Attorney Steve Williams and City Clerk Wilma Nolan.

ABSENT: Alderman Fred Welch.

MINUTES/AGENDA: Mayor Penland presented the minutes of the last meeting and the agenda of this meeting for review and approval.

Gary, "I so move." Brad seconded and the motion passed by a vote of 3 to 0.

Celeste, "I make the motion." Gary seconded and the motion passed by a vote of 3 to 0.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

FINANCE: Mr. Rowe advised he had reviewed the budget for the month ended 04-30-15 and I believe everything is in order.

INFRASTRUCTURE: Mr. Brock advised that Everett's report was available and it had been another busy month for brush and trash.

Everett advised they are in the process of getting ready to begin the project on Duvall Road. The tile replacement work will begin on June 1.

The road will be closed from June 1 until the project is completed. Hopefully, no more than two days.

Steve Smith from the Water Department was not present. However, Mr. Brock advised the solar energy project contract had been let and the project is to be completed by July.

INTERGOVERNMENTAL & TECHNOLOGY: Presentation of an amendment for first reading to amend Article III, Sec. IV: Minimum Requirements for Erosion, Sedimentation and Pollution Control Using Best Management Practices of the City of Chatsworth, Georgia.

Gary, "I make a motion we approve this as the first reading." Brad seconded and the motion passed by a vote of 3 to 0.

PRESENTATION OF AN ORDINANCE TO IMPLEMENT LICENSING PROCEDURES AND REGULATIONS REGARDING DISTILLERS FOR FIRST READING.

Chuck Butler of Dalton Distillery was present to address the council. Mr. Butler expressed that two years ago he had met with the Mayor to discuss a distillery here inside the city limits. He advised me that you were not interested two years ago. Now, I am with Dalton Distillery and have invested my entire life savings and I am shocked and hurt and ask that you really not pass this to add competition this close.

Mayor Penland advised that the main reason was you were trying to gain entrance to your location through a subdivision and that is against regulations. I told you that then.

Mr. Butler further stated that he was surprised and disappointed with this after two years.

Ms. Martin advised that this was a proactive measure and she was unaware that anyone was on board for a project such as this.

Mayor Penland called for a motion to approve the ordinance as the first reading.

Brad, "I so move." Gary seconded and the motion passed by a vote of 3 to 0.

PUBLIC SAFETY: Mr. Welch was not present so the Mayor called upon Mr. Etheridge to present his report.

Chief Etheridge advised that Sgt. Kelly Parker completed firearm instructor class on April 17. This will allow us to train on a local level. We have seen an increase in drug arrests which seems to be a current trend now.

He also had some cars with issues and Everett is switching transmissions and some other work to get them back on the road.

Chief Baxter was not present and a report was not available.

EXECUTIVE SESSION: Mayor Penland advised there was no need for an executive session.

Frank Adams reminded everyone the Depot, The Wright Hotel and the Section Master's house will be open this Saturday. These locations will be open from 11 to 4. Refreshments will be for sale and we need approval to close First Avenue.

Brad, "I would move to close the street for this event." Celeste seconded and the motion passed by a vote of 3 to 0.

Frank further advised the music will be at the hotel and this will continue for the next five months on the second Saturday of each month.

The City Marshall report was available and Celeste thanked Mr. Martin for his work and urging people to make our town cleaner.

Mayor Penland adjourned the meeting at 6:20 p.m.
