The Chatsworth City Council met in regular session on Monday, October 5, 2015 at 6:00 p.m. in the council chambers of city hall with Mayor Dan Penland presiding.

PRESENT: Mayor Dan Penland, Aldermen: Brad Rowe, Celeste Martin, Gary Brock and Fred Welch. City Attorney Steve Williams and City Clerk Wilma Nolan.

MINUTES/AGENDA: Mayor Penland presented the minutes of the last meeting and the agenda for this meeting.

Gary, "I make a motion we accept these, the minutes as written and the agenda as presented."
Fred seconded and the motion passed by a vote of 4 to 0.

NEW BUSINESS

Dinah Rowe, Chamber of Commerce, wishes to address the council regarding parking on Third Avenue - Ms. Rowe stated she had several requests that parallel parking not be allowed downtown during the Christmas parade. The children are running between the cars during the parade to get candy. The Christmas parade is scheduled for December 5, 2015. The request was not to allow parking there from about three o'clock there on that Saturday until after the parade.

Concerns would be any business that would be open during this time. Ms. Rowe advised that she had contacted some of them. Discussion followed concerning contacting the businesses, running in the paper and social media. This would affect two blocks.

The council felt this was a good safety concern however, they did not want to adversely affect any business there. Ms. Rowe will make a checklist and contact all the businesses that would be affected and check back with Josh on the matter.

Mayor Penland reviewed the information for those present. Following discussion, Mayor Penland called for a motion.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

FINANCE: Mr. Rowe advised he had reviewed the September financials. As far as expenses we are under where we would normally be based on budget, but we are way under in revenues. The December billings will start to come in for the end of the year and that will pick up the difference there and we have the insurance premium that will come in this month. This should catch up by year end.

INFRASTRUCTURE: We are still getting a lot of stuff to haul to the landfill. When we figure a way to cut this we can cut 30-40 thousand dollars from the budget. But to do that, services will have to be cut.

Mr. Jones advised that all the streets scheduled for paving have been repaired and are ready for resurfacing. They should move in later this week or next week.

The leaf machine should be in at any time.

INTERGOVERNMENTAL & TECHNOLOGY: Dolley advised they are busy with clean-ups. Tomorrow, we will be reporting to the EPD office in Atlanta for our first review on the MS4 permit of 2014.

PUBLIC SAFETY: Mr. Welch advised the reports are available and asked Chief Etheridge to report.

Chief Etheridge advised they had responded to 1804 calls for the month of September, with 30 accidents, 46 drug cases and 2 heroin cases. We would hope that November would be a slower month.

The fire reports were presented with Chief Baxter reviewing the reports.

Chief Baxter advised that it had been a very busy month. We had one extrication that was very difficult due to a high speed impact and we had to deal with a fatality. We also participated in the teen maze event at the Dalton Fairgrounds. This came out to be a very good event. We participated in the block party. We had three members attend the Guardian Center event this year. The Flames course will be held the third weekend in October. This month is fire safety month and we will begin this in all the schools this month.

Mayor Penland asked Frank Adams to convey his thanks to his daughter for taking care of the Beautification out front on the sign. I appreciate it very much.

There being nothing else to come before the council, Mayor Penland adjourned the meeting at 6:35 p.m.
