COUNCIL MEETING  
MAY 7, 2012

The Chatsworth City Council met in regular session on Monday, May 7, 2012 at 6:00 p.m. in the council chambers of City Hall with Mayor Dan Penland presiding.

PRESENT: Mayor Dan Penland, Aldermen: Wayne Graves, Celeste Martin, Gary Brock and Fred Welch. City Attorney Steve Williams and City Clerk Wilma Nolan.

Mayor Penland called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. presenting the agenda and minutes of the last meeting for approval.

Wayne, "I make a motion we approve them." Celeste seconded and the motion passed by a vote of 4 to 0.

OLD BUSINESS

Presentation of the Service Delivery Strategy Update - (Tabled last month) - Mayor Penland advised Tommy Parker with the county is here to answer questions about the service delivery strategy.

Wayne advised the main question is that we are not agreeing to the fees for Eton, Chatsworth and the County that will be taken care of later.

Tommy advised the concern was over the Economic Development Agreement. That agreement lists the

financial contributions of the county and the cities. We are simply updating the service delivery strategy a requirement of DCA which has not been done since 2007. So what we are required to do is update any changes to our Service Delivery Strategy since that time. There were a number of changes but that one in particular is raising a concern. By updating this, we are simply letting DCA know that we along with the other agreements, we have come to an agreement on economic development. This update with DCA is no way ratifies or triggers any financial obligations by any party to any party. In fact, we have all agreed to set this agreement aside and by law the county government cannot obligate beyond one year.

Mayor Penland called for a motion to approve the service delivery strategy.

Fred, "I so move." Gary seconded and the motion passed by a vote of 4 to 0.

#### NEW BUSINESS

#### COMMITTEE REPORTS

**FINANCE:** Wayne advised that all departments are within the budget. Revenues are coming in pretty good. We have collected 97.5% of the taxes.

**INFRASTRUCTURE:** Gary advised that Everett's reports are available. We have had a pretty heavy month with clean-ups.

Steve advised that the bond issue should be fixed up by the middle of June. We are in the process now that the gas is out of the tanks of getting them removed. Estes, the company removing the tanks has submitted to the state for a permit to remove the tanks.

It was advised that the two hours of drug training has been completed. Several did not complete this but we are working on completing this for those who missed the classes. The department heads still have an additional two hours of training. Gary stressed that this is mandatory and must be completed.

Dolley advised that the county is closer on getting the equipment ready for the demolition.

**INTERGOVERNMENTAL & TECHNOLOGY:** Celeste advised that as far as zoning and code enforcement goes, Dolley has worked on cleaning up some overgrown vegetation and working on demolishing some of those run down houses.

Dolley advised she had collected 34 signs this month and there are five houses to be demolished.

Celeste expressed her thrill over the new Sierra Restaurant and the Pork'N Beans Restaurant. She is very thankful for both of these places.

**PUBLIC SAFETY:** Chief Martin is out of town and Scott Bickford is here to represent that department. The reports are available. Mr. Bickford advised that three burglaries were cleared up this last month. Two residential burglaries and the Living Well Pharmacy burglary of November 2011.

Mike advised that his reports were available. Training was held in Canton and they hosted a day of training here for Cherokee County with 20 of these participants. Several guys were sent to the fire academy to teach during the Georgia firefighter weekend, Brigam Young and Joey Torres taught firefighter survival techniques. Assistant Chief Parker completed an 80 hour arson investigation course. We participated with Duluth for operation drive smart at the high school.

There was a fire at the EMS office. The hospital sent a letter of appreciation.

Mayor Penland read the letter of appreciation from the Hospital Authority, Murray Medical and Murray Emergency Medical Services. The letter was signed by the Chairman of the Hospital Authority, Chief Executive Officer of Murray Medical Center, Roy Orr and EMS supervisor Larry Ballew. Mayor Penland commended Chief Baxter and his department.

Frank Adams announced he had a Murray Green Sweep coming on Saturday, May 19, 2012 and we are offering free shredding. A shredding company is coming on site. We have Scott Recycling coming out of Tennessee to recycle electronics. We will continue to take what we normally take and we are adding clothing to the list. These will inturn pass to Snazzy Seconds where the money will go to the Northwest Georgia Crisis Center. We are also collecting eye glasses for the Chatsworth Lions Club.

There being no further business, Mayor Penland adjourned the meeting.
