Rezoning request of Johnny Waters to rezone 15.45 acres from R-1 (Low Density Residential) to R-A (Residential Agriculture) - The Planning Commission Recommendation is as follows:

Please be advised that Commissioners Jason Babb, Wendell Lance, Winston Massengale, and Troy Owens; Zoning Administrator Dolley Flood; and Staff Member Kevin McAuliff were present at the May 22, 2014 meeting of the Planning Commission to consider

The petition of John H. Waters to rezone from approximately 15.45 acres south of Hill Street and to the west of Tenth Avenue, and formerly part of the Timberbrook subdivision, from Low Density Residential (R-1) to Residential Agriculture (R-A).

After hearing the petition, the Planning Commission voted unanimously to recommend to the Mayor and City Council that the petitioner's request to rezone his property from Low Density Residential (R-1) to Residential Agriculture (R-A) be granted.

Please be further advised that Zoning Board of Appeals members Troy Owens and Tyson Haynes; Zoning Administrator Dolley Flood; and Staff Member Kevin McAuliff were present at the May 22, 2014 meeting to consider

The request of Tri-South Contractors, Inc. represented by Clyde Tant, to reduce the number of required parking spaces for a child care facility from 49 (error for "59?") to 35.

After hearing the petition, the Zoning Board of Appeals voted unanimously to grant the request, and to recommend that the Planning Commission reconsider the number of parking spaces required for child care facilities, since the current regulations are more stringent than the national norm.
