Presentation of a resolution requesting the General Assembly to include within the corporate limits of the city certain road rights of way. The resolution reads as follows:

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
 CHATSWORTH, GEORGIA REQUESTING THE GEORGIA GENERAL
 ASSEMBLY TO ENACT LOCAL LEGISLATION TO INCLUDE WITHIN
 THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY CERTAIN ROAD RIGHTS-
 OF-WAY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS in order to protect the public health, safety, welfare, the Mayor and Council of the City of Chatsworth find that annexing certain road rights-of-way into the corporate limits of the city would permit the patrolling thereof by the Chatsworth Police Department.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT HEREBY IS RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of the City of Chatsworth, Georgia, as follows:

The legislative delegation representing the City of Chatsworth in the 2017 Session of the Georgia General Assembly is hereby requested to introduce and support local legislation as may be prepared by Legislative Counsel for the purpose of annexing into the corporate limits of the City of Chatsworth certain road rights of way as may be set forth.

The City Clerk is hereby requested to transmit a certified copy of this Resolution to all members of the local delegation to the Georgia General Assembly.

FINANCE: Request the approval of line item adjustments for 2016. (Attachment)

Chairman Welch advised the 2016 tax collections were at 87%.

INFRASTRUCTURE: Chairman Cloer advised the window repairs for the fire and police stations were to begin Friday.

INTERGOVERNMENTAL & TECHNOLOGY: Chairman Martin advised that she was familiar with the contract for the ordinance codification that was presented earlier. Ms. Martin, "I recommend the republication of the code and the contract with MuniCode for this project." Jeff seconded and the motion passed by a vote of 3 to 0.

PUBLIC SAFETY: Fire reports are available. 513 calls were registered for 2016. 32 of these were fires.

Caution was issued for the cold weather with heating appliances. Portable heaters are the cause of many cold weather fires.

The Police Department had 1257 calls for December and 22 drug cases and 4 parades.

16,457 calls were registered for 2016.

There is a 29% increase in accidents.

EXECUTIVE SESSION: None

Mayor Haynes inquired of Everett for his December report.

Mr. Jones advised there were 50 loads of leaves, 30 loads brush, 17 loads debris, 99.97 tons of garbage disposed of in December.

There were \$3,700 chemical used for the snow.

Mayor Haynes adjourned the meeting at 6:47 p.m.
