Presentation of an intergovernmental agreement with Murray County for IT services. The agreement reads as follows-

INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT

This Intergovernmental Agreement (Agreement) is made and entered into, by and between Murray County, Georgia (County) and the City of Chatsworth, Georgia (City).

WITNESSETH

The County and City are mutually desirous to enter into an agreement whereby the County will make available their Information Technology (IT) employee for certain City IT projects as outlined in this agreement.

The County's IT employee will assist in all capital IT projects, including: assessment of current infrastructure, assess and provide expertise for proposed IT projects, provide for coordination of vendor activities including proposals, installation and implementation, purchasing hardware and software, design management of all IT infrastructure and any other IT services required for the

City's capital projects, both known and future capital projects.

The City agrees to contribute \$5,000 quarterly to be paid during the second month of each quarter.

The City will receive an aggregate of approximately 23% of the available time budgeted. The County will keep time records for future evaluation.

This agreement will continue from month-to-month and year-to-year. Either party will exercise the option to terminate this agreement following a sixty (60) day written notice.
