Dear Mayor Penland:

Please accept this as an agreement between the Northwest Georgia Regional Commission (NWGRC) and the City of Chatsworth regarding NWGRC delivery of general planning and development control consultation and administration services to the City.

The type and scope of services to be provided are identified in attached Exhibit A.

You agree to pay us for work done based on NWGRC's staff cost rate of \$48.00 per hour (\$384.00 per Day) for planner services and \$37.00 per hour (\$296.00 per day) for planner technician services. We agreed to keep accurate records pertaining to this project which will be available for your review. Payments will be based on a request for reimbursement of time expended and expenses incurred, which will be accompanied by a report of activities.

This agreement shall be in effect for twelve (12) months beginning July 1, 2015. You have the right to change the work scope as set out in Exhibit A if you give us specific instructions in writing. You shall also have the right to terminate this contract upon thirty (30) days notice, but we shall be entitled to payment for services provided.

EXHIBIT A: SCOPE OF SERVICES

Exhibit A to the agreement between Northwest Georgia Regional Commission and the City of Chatsworth for NWGRC to provide general planning and development controls administrative services to the City as necessary according to the following arrangements and activities.

Description of Work Activities

1. Consultation services to the City Council, Chatsworth Planning Commission, Zoning Board of Appeals, Building Inspector, and other city staff regarding interpretation, administration, and enforcement of the city's development regulations.
2. Preparation and/or review and analysis of routine amendments to the city's zoning district map and other development regulations.
3. Consultation and review of annexation initiatives or requests.
4. Review and analysis of all proposed subdivision plats occurring in the city.
5. Maintaining and updating the City's base maps and zoning map.
6. Administration assistance to the Chatsworth Planning Commission and Zoning Board of Appeals including attending meetings, and maintaining relevant records.

Estimated Costs

Actual costs would depend on actual demand for the services described times the manday (hourly) cost rates.

Fred, "I make a motion we accept it." Celeste seconded and the motion passed by a vote of 3 to 0.

Steve Smith of the Chatsworth Water Works Commission request the signing of a power of attorney to recover the sales tax on the solar project -

Steve advised this was a 75/25 split. The attorney recommends this. It has not been done on a solar project before. However, we have nothing to loose as we have nothing now.

FINANCE: Mayor Penland reviewed the numbers thru 08-31-15 and it appears that all the departments are within the percentage of their budgets for this time of year.

INFRASTRUCTURE: Gary advised that 27 tons of garbage were picked up with the garbage truck and 25 loads were picked up by hand. We are creating problems. I do not believe everyone understands the rules of our garbage pickup. May items that can be placed in the container are being thrown on the ground for hand pickup. Cardboard boxes can be broken down and placed in the container. Items picked up by hand are disposed of at a higher disposal rate.

Lengthy discussion followed regarding the pickup of discarded items. A letter is to be composed regarding the rules to better inform the public.

PUBLIC SAFETY: Chief Etheridge presented his reports. He advised they had responded to 1682 calls for service. There were 37 felony warrants taken. All types of drugs are really rampant.

Two letter of commendation were presented for the police department.
