COMMITTEE REPORTS

FINANCE: All the departments are within budget reported Mr. Graves. We have collected 91% of the property taxes.

INFRASTRUCTURE: The water department did not have anything to report.

Mr. Jones advised they had disposed of 20.8 tons of trash from the street, 23 loads of brush, 75.64 tons of sanitation waste. New street signs have been installed in Plantation Acres as requested by 911. Street lights on Market Street have been repaired and are now working. The water works assisted the street department in some drainage work and Mr. Jones expressed his appreciation for their assistance.

INTERGOVERNMENTAL & TECHNOLOGY: Ms. Martin advised they are waiting on cost estimates from Municode for updating the code.

PUBLIC SAFETY: Presentation of a Law Enforcement Operations Manual for adoption.

Chief Martin advised this has not been updated in about ten years. This is more up to date and in depth as to the needs of the department.

Fred, "I make a motion we adopt the Law Enforcement Operations Manual." Gary seconded and the motion passed by a vote of 4 to 0.

Fred advised the Police Committee had met on this and agreed with it.

Chief Martin's reports were available. He advised burglaries and thefts are up and accidents were down.

Chief Baxter presented his reports. Emergency medical calls were up and a good bit of training had been completed. They participated in reading day and hosted a Dalton recruit training class.

Mayor Penland read the following letter:

To City of Chatsworth

On the evening of Friday, July 27, 2012 the Summerville Fire Department responded to a commercial structure fire in the Berryton Community of our county. Due to the large size of the fire, the material involved and its location in a primarily residential area, it was quickly evident that additional resources would be needed. Your agency was one of the many who heeded the call for help and I would like to express our appreciation for the incredible performance displayed by your personnel. Not only did they respond in a timely and organized fashion, they also operated on scene with professionalism, competence and great effectiveness.

This fire, which involved hazardous materials, required an evacuation of the Berryton Community and was difficult to battle due to the large size and intensity of the fire. Fire units not only battled the fire, but also the extreme heat with daytime temperatures in the 90's during the incident. Fire personnel and equipment were on the scene continuously for 5 days until the last fire unit left on August 1, 2012.

Your personnel were able to perform every task requested of them in a safe, effective and efficient manner. Their dedication to their profession and willingness to help a neighbor is to be commended.

In the end, the personnel and resources you provided significantly contributed to our ability to control and extinguish this fire. Thank you for allowing them to assist us.
