Dear Mayor Penland,

I am writing this in response to a request from Everett Jones to assess the health and risk associated with a 62.5 inch Willow Oak at 101 North Fourth Avenue in Chatsworth. I am a certified Arborist in good standing with the International Society of Arboriculture and I am employed by the City of Dalton Public Works Department. I routinely do Basic Risk Assessments for the City of Dalton to protect the public from risks associated with street trees and Park trees.

The tree in question stands next to William Keith's law office. I found it to be in serious decline with a lot of tip dieback, root decay fungal fruiting bodies, hollowing and loss of buttress roots, and epicormic growth. The root decay alone makes me uneasy about failure of the root system at some point in the near future. The frequency of use of the targets, the size of the parts and likelihood of failure are evaluate as high risk by me. Therefore it is my determination that the tree should be removed and another planted to take this one's place. I am enclosing the Basic Tree Risk Assessment form and accompanying photographs to substantiate my findings.
