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Fred presented the proposed budgets to the council for adoption. Fred, "I recommend we adopt the budgets as presented. These are the same as we presented in the public hearings, there have been no changes."

Celeste seconded and the motion passed by a vote of 3 to 0.

Presentation of the MS4 report by Dolley Flood.

Dolley presented a report on the Chatsworth-Murray County Stormwater. She advised there were three sections - erosion, complaints, education.

A website has been established - <http://chatsworth-murraystormwater.com>.

The maps and inspections are 31% complete. A work order system has been established with written logs and ipads. All information has been established on the website with additional updates coming.

The annual report is due on 02-15-17.

Plan reviews are completed at the water works.

Illicit discharge is monitored with a work order system. This area is 80% completed.

Another vital part is public awareness. A letter is being mailed with business license renewals to provide more awareness to the public of EPD requirements.

Discharge complaints are monitored with the maintenance of projects. Rock Bridge has the first pond. Monitoring of this will be on-going.

This will be an on-going and ever changing project as the requirements are implemented and conditions change.

Presentation of an amendment to the Service Delivery Agreement for adoption. The agreement reads as follows:

Amendment to Building Inspection and Permitting  
Service Delivery Agreement

WHEREAS, the current Service Delivery Agreement, between Murray County, a political subdivision of the State of Georgia, formed and existing pursuant to the Constitution of the State of Georgia, and the City of Chatsworth, and the City of Eton, all being a municipal corporation chartered and existing pursuant to the laws of the State of Georgia; and

WHEREAS, 37-7-20 through 37-7-28 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated mandates that Murray County and all the municipalities located therein shall participate in the development of a Service Delivery Strategy through which Murray County and said municipalities shall create and maintain a service delivery system which is efficient, effective and responsive to all the citizens of Murray County; and

WHEREAS, 37-20-28(B)(1)-(6) of the Official Code of Georgia mandates that each County and affected municipality shall review, and revise if necessary, the approved strategy; and

WHEREAS, Murray County and the City of Chatsworth, both employee personnel, certified Building Inspection and Permitting services: and

NOW, THEREFORE, we, the undersigned, being duly authorized to act on behalf of the above named entities, agree, as follows, concerning the provisions of Building Inspection and Permitting within Murray County.

WITNESSETH

Section I

Description of Current Service Delivery Arrangement

Murray County provides Building Inspection and Permitting services in the unincorporated areas of Murray County and within the incorporated city limits of the City of Chatsworth and the City of Eton as outlined in the Service Delivery Agreement.

Section II

Future Service Delivery Strategy Arrangement

The Parties hereto agree that there is no need to continue the current service delivery arrangement between Murray County and the City of Chatsworth, and that Murray County will continue to provide Building and Permitting services for the unincorporated area of the County and the incorporated limits of the City of Eton. The City of Chatsworth will be the sole provider of Building Inspection and Permitting within the incorporated limits of the City of Chatsworth.

IN WITNESS THEREOF, each of the undersigned has executed this Service Delivery Agreement on behalf of the respective parties set forth below, pursuant to the authority granted to each of the undersigned in the resolution by which each party approved and adopted this Service Delivery Agreement.
