The Chatsworth City Council met in regular session on Monday, May 2, 2016 at 6:00 p.m. in the council chambers of city hall with Mayor Tyson Haynes presiding.

PRESENT: Mayor Tyson Haynes, Aldermen: Brad Rowe, Celeste Martin, Jeff Cloer and Fred Welch. City Attorney Steve Williams and City Clerk Wilma Nolan.

MINUTES:AGENDA:

Mayor Haynes presented the minutes of the March 7 meeting for review and the agenda for tonight's meeting. The April meeting was not held due to the lack of quorum.

Fred, "I make a motion we accept the minutes." Brad seconded and the motion passed by a vote of 4 to 0.

NEW BUSINESS

Presentation of Mr. Michael McPherson, Governmental Relations Associate of GMA, for the presentation of the Champion of Georgia Cities Award to Senator Bethel.

Mr. McPherson came forward for the presentation. Senator Charlie Bethel was presented with the Champion of Georgia Cities Award on behalf of the Georgia Municipal Association.

Request the appointment of Rhett Griffin to replace Johnny Peeples on the Chatsworth Housing Authority. This is a five year term to expire April 2021.

Fred, "I so move." Celeste seconded and the motion passed by a vote of 4 to 0.

Presentation of the recommendation of the March 17, 2016 planning commission meeting and the proposed ordinance amendment for the first reading.

Brad, "I so move we adopt this as the first reading." Fred seconded and the motion passed by a vote of 4 to 0.

Presentation of a proposed amendment to the Drug and Alcohol policy for first reading.

Mayor Haynes explained the changes reflected in this amendment.

Fred, "I make a motion we accept the proposed amendment as the first reading." Celeste seconded and the motion passed by a vote of 4 to 0.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

**FINANCE:** Brad stated in reviewing the report, there is nothing out of the ordinary to report. Overall we are on schedule.

One personal note, I want to thank the Mayor for his kind remarks in presenting me with the inaugural mayor award at the Chamber banquet and it is something that I will cherish.

**ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT, TOURISM & DEVELOPMENT:** At the current time the city has an annexation request on Rollie Avenue. We are working on annexation of some islands that were created a number of years ago as well as working with the DDA on expanding the CBD district.

Celeste stated she was happy to have this audio/visual equipment and bringing our council room up a few years with its technological conveniences. This is a great addition for our meetings as well as for the court.

**PUBLIC SAFETY:** Fred presented the fire department reports and training reports. Chief Baxter advised it was a normal month. We spent two days training with law enforcement personnel to develop skills in active shooter incidents.

Fred presented the police department reports for review. He inquired of three auto thefts. Chief Etheridge advised that this was correct. They also worked 36 accidents, 46 drug cases, 51 warrants, 140 arrests, 210 cases and 307 warnings. We had civilian responses with an active shooter during a domestic disturbance. We need more training with this type of incidents. We sold four confiscated vehicles thru Govdeals for a total of \$226. Kelly Parker conducted a training course for DFACS.

**PUBLIC WORKS.:** Jeff advised the new backhoe had been received. We have also ordered a new truck that is not in at this time. We have placed the old backhoe and a dump truck on Govdeals. We have done some mulching on Market Street and more is planned. The tile project on Locust Street has been completed. We have also completed the Fifth Avenue tile project. We placed 25 loads in the landfill, 61 loads of brush and 16 loads of trash to the landfill.

Mayor Haynes advised he had requested \$68,000 thru the LMIG Off System Safety Grant for striping and sidewalk repairs. We will be notified by June 30, if we receive anything. The good thing is that it is a 30% match.

Frank Adams advised that this was the second season of homegrown talent in the park by the Historical Society. The Wright Hotel will be open on May 14, 2016 from 12 - 5 p.m. for tours and the concert will begin at 5 p.m.

Dinah Rowe of the Chamber expressed her appreciation of the cleaning and mulching on Market Street.

There was a student present observing the meeting for his class project.

**EXECUTIVE SESSION:** Mayor Haynes advised there was a need for an executive session. Mayor Haynes called for a motion to enter into executive session.

Fred, "I so move," Brad seconded and the motion passed by a vote of 4 to 0.

The members returned from the executive session. Mayor Haynes called for a motion to return to regular session.

Fred, "I so move." Celeste seconded and the motion passed by a vote of 4 to 0.

Mayor Haynes advised that it was the recommendation of the Mayor and Council to uphold the termination of Timothy Benson.

Brad, "I make a motion to that effect." Fred seconded and the motion passed by a vote of 4 to 0.

Mayor Haynes called for a motion to adjourn.

Fred, "I so move." Celeste seconded and the motion passed by a vote of 4 to 0.

The meeting was adjourned at 6:35 p.m.
