NEW BUSINESS

Presentation of an intergovernmental agreement between the City of Chatsworth the Chatsworth Water Works for adoption. The agreement reads as follows:

INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT

This Intergovernmental Agreement ("Agreement") is made and entered into, by and between the City of Chatsworth, Georgia (City) and the City of Chatsworth Water Works Commission (Commission).

WITNESSETH

The City and Commission are mutually desirous to enter into an Agreement whereby the Commission will transfer two and one half percent (2.5%) of its annual collected gross revenue to the City. Said funds may be used by the City at its discretion to fund operation of the city and services as it deems necessary.

- (1) This Agreement will supersede the previous agreements or arrangements for payments to the City by the Commission for collection of funds as listed below.
 - a. One dollar (\$1.00) transfer fee per billed account by the Commission.
 - b. Fifty cents (\$0.50) per thousand - gallon for all sewer billed outside the incorporated city limits of the City of Chatsworth.
- (2) Payment shall be made monthly and will be calculated at two and one half percent (2.5%) of collected gross revenues for that month and will be paid no later than thirty (30) days from the end of each month.
- (3) This Agreement shall not affect any previous agreements or arrangements for services or payment other than those items listed in section (1) a and b.
- (4) The parties hereto agree the duration of this Agreement shall be for a period not to exceed 20 years. The parties hereto agree this Agreement can only be terminated by the mutual consent of both parties or reduced by exceptions contained in section (5).
- (5) In the event the Commission experiences a loss of revenue for an extended period of time which creates the necessity for the use of reserve funds to operate, the Commission may request to return to prior agreements and arrangements as listed in section (1) a and b in lieu of th two and one half percent (2.5%). If approved by the City normal payments per this agreement would resume once revenues and reserve funds return to pre-loss levels.
- (6) IN WITNESS WHEREOF, each of the undersigned has executed this Agreement on behalf of the respective party set forth below, pursuant to the authority granted to each of the undersigned in the resolution by which each party approved and adopted in this Agreement.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

FINANCE: Fred advised the taxes are coming in and we are keeping an eye on the budget at the current time.

ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT, TOURISM & DEVELOPMENT: Celeste inquired of Dolley to update on new businesses. Dolley advised that Big Rock Outfitters and Burger King both planned to open before the end of year.

Celeste further advised the Economic Development Authority was preparing a job description for an economic development coordinator and the hiring of an individual for this position.

PUBLIC SAFETY: Chief Etheridge advised they had 12 burglaries in October. There was also an obstruction case where the taser was used. There were 37 domestic calls with a total of 1190 calls.

Chief Baxter advised they had 44 alarms and five fires. Windstream had a roof fire due to HVAC overheating.

They had 480 hours of training. The fire truck had a mechanical issue and was out of service. It was put back in service on 11-09-2016.

PUBLIC WORKS: Jeff advised all the sidewalks had been finished. Repair of the windows at the police and fire station are underway. The street striping should be completed next week.
