The Chatsworth City Council met in regular session on Monday, August 7, 2017 at 6:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers of City Hall with Mayor Tyson Haynes presiding.

PRESENT: MAYOR Tyson Haynes. **ALDERMAN:** Rhett Griffin, Celeste Martin, Jeff Cloer and Fred Welch. City Attorney Steve Williams and City Clerk Wilma Nolan.

Mayor Haynes presented the minutes of the last meeting and the proposed agenda for review and the addition of one item on the agenda following the stormwater update the action on the Homeland Security approval request for the bomb sniffing dog and equipment funding for consideration.

NEW BUSINESS

Request the approval of a malt beverage and wine license for Alex Anthony/Angelina Food & Fuel Inc. dba Kwikserv 16 2909 Hwy 76, Chatsworth, Georgia.

Chief Etheridge advised this was in order. Rhett, "I make a motion we approve the malt beverage and wine license."

Fred seconded and the motion passed by a vote of 4 to 0.

Appointment of members to the Downtown Development Authority-

The recommendation of the appointment of Fred Welch, Dinah Rowe, and Illya Copeland to the DDA for a term to expire 04-30-20 has been presented.

Celeste, "I make a motion we appoint them." Rhett seconded and the motion passed by a vote of 4 to 0.

Selection of Charles Road or Long Avenue for submission of the L.M.I.G. funding for 2018 to GDOT.

Fred, "I make a recommendation we do Charles Road first due to population and traffic counts and Long the year after."

Jeff seconded and the motion passed by a vote of 4 to 0.

Presentation of the storm water update by Dolley Flood.

Dolley reported on the stormwater advising the 2015 annual report had been accepted. A response has not been received on the 2014 report. The 2016 report has been filed. The EPD reviewing is about a year behind. The new permit will become effective on 12-06-17 and will be good for five years. We have received the proposed 2018 recommendations and a copy is available if you would like a copy.

All apps are working and Hayden is working on the mapping. It should take about a month to get all this entered on the municipal facilities and pond inspections. This year we will have to complete these. Last year we did not have to do them. Work orders will continue to be entered on our apps. Everett has done a good job on getting me all the information needed. We now have all the GPS mapping equipment and the storm water apps are finished and they work. The stormwater website has been reviewed and updated and created a stormwater newsletter. Blue cards are being created to issue upon repeated violations for residential and industrial uses which continue to violate the illicit discharges ordinance. At this time they pertain to yard trimmings, dog waste, washing cars and parking lot clearing.

Our cost is basically covered with our intergovernmental agreement.

Homeland Security Approval For a Bomb Sniffing Dog and Equipment - The cost is provided by the Department of Homeland Security and our cost being \$6000 capital expenses and overtime costs.

Rhett, "I make a motion we accept this offer from the Department of Homeland Security."

Celeste seconded and the motion passed by a vote of 4 to 0.

Schedule the September council meeting - Mayor Haynes recommended the council meeting be held on September 5, 2017 at 6:00 p.m.

Fred, "I make a motion we schedule it for September 5, 2017 at 6:00 p.m."

Rhett seconded and the motion passed by a vote of 4 to 0.
