COUNCIL MEETING
CITY OF CHATSWORTH
MARCH 5, 2018

The Chatsworth City Council met in regular session on Monday, March 5, 2018 at 6:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers of City Hall with Mayor Tyson Haynes presiding.

PRESENT: Mayor Tyson Haynes, Aldermen: Rhett Griffin, K. W. Gong, Jeff Cloer, and Fred Welch. City Clerk Wilma Nolan.

ABSENT: City Attorney Steve Williams

Mayor Haynes called the meeting to order and presented the minutes of the last meeting and the agenda for the March meeting and the addition of one item under new business - an appointment to the Chatsworth Housing Authority.
