Presentation of the second reading of an ordinance of amendment to the zoning map of the City of Chatsworth for the property of RMR Commerce LLC. located at 1173 Highway 76 to be rezoned to C-2 (General Commercial).

The amendment reads as follows:

FILE REFERENCE NO#. 090618

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE ZONING MAP OF THE CITY OF CHATSWORTH

REZONING the following property located at 1173 Highway 76, Chatsworth, Georgia. Formerly known as Selmer West property, parcel number 0048A-043 known as Tract 1 containing 10.79 acres. The property is currently zoned as an overlay district and has been petitioned by the owners for a rezoning request to C-2 (General Commercial).

WHEREAS, application has been filed by RMR Commerce LLC requesting the rezoning of the said property; and

WHEREAS, following proper notice, a public hearing was held before this body; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council do hereby find as a fact that said petition meets the requirements of the current adopted Zoning Ordinance,

The above described property to be rezoned as (C-2) General Commercial and hereby declared to be in the intention of this Ordinance that it's sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses and phrases are severable, and if any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance is declared to be invalid, it shall not affect any of the remaining sections, paragraphs, clauses or phrases of this Ordinance.

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

This Ordinance shall become effective upon the signature of the Mayor, subject to Georgia Law of 1993, page 4119.
