TO: COMMERCIAL GARBAGE CUSTOMERS

The Chatsworth City Council voted to eliminate Garbage Service to all businesses within the city limits at its monthly meeting in April.

Over the last two years, Chatsworth government has encountered rising fuel costs and dumping charges. Our focus is to make sure we provide services to all private citizens within the City in the most efficient way. The Sanitation Committee has reviewed the cost associated with providing garbage service to our businesses over the last two years. In the last two years we have experienced losses over \$100,000. We cannot continue to provide this service to our businesses with our current setup. In order to provide a cost effective service we would need to invest in larger containers and more equipment to handle the large amount of waste. With the amount of garbage we collect and dump at the land field for businesses, we cannot afford to invest in these requirements.

The last day for city pickup for businesses will be June 29, 2012.
